Go Green Business Center

Now, you are asking yourself, what is the Go Green Business Center? That is the name of the school building after the building is converted to renewable energy. A bonding bill for the total amount of the conversion was introduced in the Minnesota Senate last week. This week the companion bill will be introduced by the House. On the Federal side, the project has been logged into the system awaiting details in the Federal Stimulus package. At this point, the project has a very good chance of being funding the \$300,000 needed to convert the building to geothermal, wind and solar energy. Upon completion, two businesses will be housed in the Go Green Business Center and that will be the beginning of a "green" energy business incubator. Very exciting stuff!!

In the meantime, *the city is still accepting donations for fuel oil.* Fuel oil in the amount of \$24,000 was purchased in January. Donations totaling a little over \$6,000 have been received to date. Any amount is being accepted and *p.s. you don't have to be a farmer.*

Lastly, regarding the building. Minors are not allowed in the building except with an adult presence somewhere in the building. If a minor is found to be in the building without an adult, the key used will be returned immediately to the city. We know kids are generally good but things happen when unsupervised. And please, do not roam the halls unless completing a walking program. Minors should stay contained to fitness center and/or gym area.
