UPDATE ON THE SCHOOL PROJECT

You may have noticed a little action around the area of the school in the last month. The geothermal heating units are being installed along with all the duct work. The shop area is finished and is heating at this time. There are two other units to be installed that will heat different portions of the building. The wings of the building will be blocked off and not heated but have doors for access. If you would like a tour of the project, please contact the city office.

The wind turbine is slated for construction mid-March. That is dependent on weather. The turbine will be erected on a 90 foot tower. The turbine is 33 kW generator. The construction deadline on all phases of the project is June 1, 2010. We are hoping for sooner than that!
