Two Fundraisers Next Week

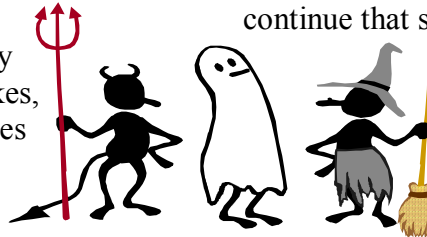

Snow Goes the Battle

The city council approved the Snow Removal Policy for the city. The entire copy is available at the city office or on the city website www.cityofkennedy.com.



*Winter parking regulations will also go into effect in November. Commercial property owners that have approached the council and agree to pay the following fees will have snow removed in the order that they have approached the council. Snow will be removed at the rate of \$50.00 per hour with hours accruing each month. Commercial owners will receive a monthly statement from the City. Removal rates will be reviewed annually and are subject to change. **Residents are encouraged to obtain their own means of snow removal.** If the city needs to clean any private property for residents, each person will be charged \$50.00 for each time regardless of how long it takes or how much snow has accumulated. Removal rates for residential driveways will also be reviewed an-*

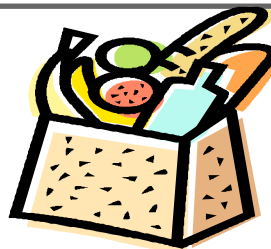
HELP THE CARE AND SHARE PANTRY
