



## Who is on the City Council?

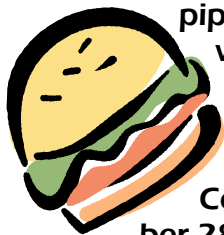
With all the changes that the summer brought forth, you residents were never updated on who took the different positions on the city council.
